- Damaged several perimeter brick wall panels, which City of OKC repaired
- Muddy water flooded Fenwick pond for 2 hours
- About 2,000 dead fish removed by City & pond company, Notified DEA.
- The City denied HOA's reimbursement claim, citing "no negligence."
- ✓ Fish restocked in late October...
- ✓ Water main broke in April and again Oct. 31.


